



Asthma AE-C Certification Prep Course: Present an in-depth review of asthma education based on the National Asthma Educator Certification Board (NAECB) detailed content outline.

12 Contact Hours

Objectives: (1) Explain trends in asthma prevalence. (2) Determine individual patient's levels of severity and control. (3) Evaluate barriers to adherence as they apply to self-assessment and self-management of asthma. (4) Utilizing problem based learning, optimize a plan of care for patients' with asthma.

Becoming an Asthma Educator and Care Manager (BAECM) Course: This course is dedicated to teaching participants to holistically approach the education of patients and families with asthma. Care topics discussed are asthma prevalence, goals of therapy, pathophysiology, controlling factors that contribute to severity, pharmacotherapy, medical administration, monitor symptoms, co-morbidities, and optimizing education. Application of core topics is reviewed through interactive case studies.
